#### Attachment A: Pre-Proposal Agenda and Sign-In Sheet

Question No. 1: With the State's upcoming CS RFP launch expected by the end of the year, could you elaborate on the County's timing for site control and site permitting?

Answer No. 1: Ordinance 2022-5 and Resolution 2022-54 were passed in July providing for the ordinance changes necessary in the Sustainable Land Development Code (SLDC), to allow for community solar without zoning restrictions, throughout the County. If the project adheres to permitting requirements as stated in the SLDC, and if the project has received a letter of compliance through the Technical Advisory Committee review (for the purpose of the CS RFP applicant scoring process), and the organization is awarded, with the approval from the PRC and State for the project to proceed, the County permit will be issued upon receipt of this proof. The letter of compliance serves as an "in lieu of permit statement", assuring the permit for the project will be released upon satisfaction of the PRC and State approval.

Site control is dependent upon the timeline of the completion of the Lease agreement between the County and the applicant. The Lease will be contingent upon project approval by the State and PRC. Since there are a number of steps that are required before the lease is approved by the Board of County Commissioners and the NM Board of Finance, lease finalization can take between 60-90 days.

Question No. 2: Looking at some of the sites provided in Exhibit B, it was unclear if they were in PNM territory. Could you provide each site's utility provider to confirm CS program eligibility?

Answer No. 2: Electric utilities are provided by PNM for all of the parcels listed.

Question No. 3: Is the County interested in serving as an offtaker to a portion of the CS site energy?

Answer No. 3: Yes, the County is very interested in being a substantial subscriber (20% minimum and 40% if possible) of the Community Solar project.

Question No. 4: Is parcel 99303165 or any other parcels landfills?

Answer No. 4: Yes, parcel 99308762 is a closed landfill, parcel 99303165 is majority landfill usage, 99303163 and 99303164 are partially landfill usage.

Ownership of parcels, 99303163 Baca; 99303164 BLM; and 99303165 Montoya is with Santa Fe Solid Waste Management Agency (SFSWMA), who is in full support of the community solar development. Developers will need to negotiate directly with SFSWMA for these parcels. They will remain on the list of available properties for community solar.

Please add this Addendum No. 1 to the original proposal documents and refer to proposal documents, hereto as such. This and all subsequent addenda will become part of any resulting contract documents and have effects as if original issued. All other unaffected sections will have their original interpretation and remain in full force and effect.
