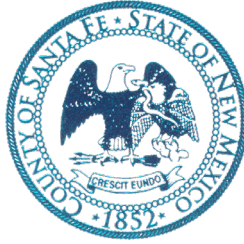

ADDENDUM #1

Dear Proponents,

This addendum is issued to reflect the following immediately. It shall be the responsibility of interested Offerors to adhere to any changes or revisions to the IFB as identified in this Addendum No. 1. This documentation shall become permanent and made part of the departmental files.

Question #1: What would be the character dimensions? They say that “special signs may be manufactured using machine cut letters or digital printing”. We don’t price per character unless it’s outside of digital printing using another substitute for character letters. If we are to price per character (letter or number) we would need dimensions. Can you provide us with dimensions?

Answer #1: After the receipt of the sheeted aluminum, SFC designs, lays out and fabricates all signs with the needed text or legends. These bid items would be used in the event I wanted to purchase, for example, 200 pre-fabricated stop signs speed limit signs, etc.

Question #2: Page 10-under qualified bidder: All bidders may be required to include references from (3) or more places of business that these items were sold to. Just in case none of the business has had ever purchased the same items? What do we do?

Answer #2: **If none of the businesses has ever purchased the same items, then you would not have (3) references.**

Question #3: Page 12 – under method of award, I could not find item 35 nor 36?

Answer #3: Numbers 35 -36 have been deleted due to changes in the bid sheet; however, the “Historic Markers” are items 29-33.

Question #4: Please clarify for me the reason these items are out for bid. We have a GSD Agreement #40-000-14-00058 valid through Feb 2019, and to this point have been the supplier for for Aluminum Blanks and Historical Markers in the State of NM.

Answer #4: This IFB is a "Multiple Source Award", which is necessary to meet the needs of the Department and Santa Fe County Purchasing Department intends to award multiple contracts.
