Answer No. 1:

The shortcuts mean creating a "shortcut" or a phrase word like, "exemptions" that links to information or a response that we have developed in the past 8 years to answer property/valuation/assessment questions efficiently and quickly.

Canned Reponses include frequently asked questions that have been asked before or more consistently that can be re-shared to answer a question. Refer to samples of shortcuts/canned messages below:

Anything Else	Is there anything else I can assist you with?
Assessment	Our office is responsible for the assessment and valuation of properties and to make these assessments, our office uses comparable sales of similar properties. When a property is purchased, the first year after the sale, the assessed value will be the market value of that property. In New Mexico, for residential properties, we have what is called the 3% cap.

	What this means is that for residential properties that have not had a change in ownership, the assessed value cannot increase more than 3% per year. The county does have various tax rates depending on the school districts, and the tax rates are set by the State of New Mexico in September. The County Treasurer's office is responsible for the tax bills and collection
	of taxes.
