

**GOVERNMENT ENTITY AUTHORIZED USER AGREEMENT
FOR STATE OF NEW MEXICO CONTRACT FOR WIRELESS SERVICES (# 81-000-00-00067)**

Verizon Wireless and the State of New Mexico (the "State") have entered into the State of New Mexico Price Agreement for Wireless Communication Services and Related Equipment, (#81-000-00-00067) (the "Master Agreement"), which must be used by executive branch state agencies. Other government bodies within the State, including non-executive branch state agencies and local public bodies (non-executive government entities), may use the Master Agreement to purchase wireless services and products from Verizon Wireless, so long as they have complied with the State's designated purchasing processes, any and all applicable local purchasing statutes and ordinances, and the applicable requirements of their individual Charters or other governing documents. A non-executive government entity using the Master Agreement shall be referred to herein as "Authorized User".

The undersigned, on behalf of the Authorized User, states, acknowledges and agrees, as follows:

- (1) It is eligible, and desires to purchase wireless services and products from Verizon Wireless pursuant to the terms and conditions of the Master Agreement and this User Agreement, and any and all addenda and schedules as the State may specify from time to time;
- (2) Authorized User will provide documentation and substantiate Authorized User status as appropriate and as requested from time to time by Verizon Wireless;
- (3) Authorized User will ensure that this User Agreement will be used only in support of government business;
- (4) Authorized User is not subject to the order and delivery processes set forth in the Master Agreement as they relate to State Department of IT ("DoIT"), and will establish such processes independently, upon mutual agreement with Verizon Wireless;
- (5) Authorized User's Verizon Wireless account will be independent of any other State or local government accounts and will be billed as such;
- (6) Authorized User bears financial responsibility for its account including all undisputed charges incurred by its subscribers;
- (7) Authorized User cannot share or pool minutes with other government accounts;
- (8) Authorized User's reporting needs will be determined on a case-by-case basis. Reporting will be provided at the account level, meaning that Authorized User cannot obtain reports pertaining to other government accounts;
- (9) Verizon Wireless may provide DoIT with aggregate information about Authorized User's usage under the Master Agreement, upon request by DoIT;
- (10) Authorized User shall designate an "Authorized Contact" (also referred to as "SPOC") who is authorized to act on behalf of Authorized User with respect to the handling of any and all matters contemplated by this User Agreement and the Master Agreement, including purchase of equipment, adding/cancelling lines of service, and making changes to the account that financially bind the Authorized User to the terms and conditions of this User Agreement, and the Master Agreement; and
- (11) The undersigned is designated and granted authority to act on behalf of the Authorized User for any and all matters contemplated by Authorized User.
