



Santa Fe County Seeks Capital Improvements Advisory Committee Members

Santa Fe County is seeking 5 volunteer committee members to serve on the Capital Improvements Advisory Committee. The Committee is appointed by the Board of County Commissioners to:

- Advise and assist the County in adopting and updating land use assumptions.
- Review and advise on the capital improvement plan (CIP), including addressing inequities or imposing impact fees.
- Monitor and evaluate implementation of the CIP.
- File annual reports on the progress of the CIP.

Committee members shall reside within Santa Fe County. No less than two members must be representative of the real estate, development, or building industries. No member shall be an employee of any governmental entity.
