4 WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Santa Fe County, New Mexico, (the  
5 "Board") has heretofore adopted a resolution (the "Bond Election Resolution") calling for an election  
6 upon the following questions:

7 Shall the County of Santa Fe, New Mexico be authorized to issue its  
8 general obligation bonds, in one or more series, in an aggregate principal  
9 amount not exceeding \$12,000,000 to acquire necessary real estate for  
10 open space, open space trails, and related areas and facilities within the  
11 County to establish "The Wildlife Mountain Trails and Historic Places  
12 Program" in order to preserve historic and natural areas, including  
13 mountains and foothills, arroyos and river parkways, sacred sites, trails,  
14 and high desert habitats containing wildlife and native plants and to  
15 provide neighborhood parks and playfields for families and children,  
16 which Program shall be subject to annual audit and review by an  
17 independent citizen oversight committee, said bonds to be issued and sold  
18 as permitted by law?

21 WHEREAS, the Bond Election Resolution was duly adopted and is in accordance with  
22 law;

23 NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Santa  
24 Fe County, New Mexico, as follows:

25 Section 1. That the election (the "Election") called for by the Bond Election Resolution  
26 shall be held in Santa Fe County, New Mexico, on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of November, 1998 (the "Election  
27 Date").

28 Section 2. The Notice of Election shall be published in full with the General Election  
29 Proclamation and, in substantially the following form with only such changes as are approved by the  
30 Chairman of the Board, and as provided by law, in English and Spanish, once a week for at least two  
31 (2) consecutive weeks, and the County Clerk shall obtain affidavits of publication thereof and shall  
32 file the same with the minutes of this meeting:

**NOTICE OF SANTA FE COUNTY GENERAL OBLIGATION  
BOND ELECTION TO BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 3, 1998**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that at a bond election (the "Election") to be held in the County of Santa Fe, New Mexico (the "County") on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of November, 1998, there will be presented for vote to the qualified registered electors of the County the following question:

Shall the County of Santa Fe, New Mexico be authorized to issue its general obligation bonds, in one or more series, in an aggregate principal amount not exceeding \$12,000,000 to acquire necessary real estate for open space, open space trails, and related areas and facilities within the County to establish "The Wildlife Mountain Trails and Historic Places Program" in order to preserve historic and natural areas, including mountains and foothills, arroyos and river parkways, sacred sites, trails, and high desert habitats containing wildlife and native plants and to provide neighborhood parks and playfields for families and children, which Program shall be subject to annual audit and review by an independent citizen oversight committee, said bonds to be issued and sold as permitted by law?

The bonds shall have a net effective interest rate of not more than ten percent (10%) per year, unless the State Board of Finance at any time prior to delivery of the bonds approves a higher net effective interest rate in writing, and the bonds shall mature not more than 20 years from their date.

Early voter precincts open from 12:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m., October 14, 1998 to October 31, 1998, at the Santa Fe County Fair Building, corner of Rodeo Road & Richards Avenue, East of Rodeo Grounds and 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. October 14, 1998 to October 31, 1998 at the Santa Fe County Administration Building, 102 Grant Avenue Corner of Grant Avenue and Palace Avenue.

Absentee voter precinct, open from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. from September 24, 1998 to October 31, 1998, is the Clerk's Office, 102 Grant Avenue, Santa Fe, New Mexico.

The polls, except the absentee and early voter precincts set forth above, for the Election will be open between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. on November 3, 1998. The polls shall be located within the County as follows:

1 No ballot on the bond election shall be received unless, on the date of the  
2 election, the person offering to vote is a registered, qualified elector of the County. The registration  
3 books of the County shall be closed by the County Clerk at 5:00 p.m. on October 6, 1998. Any person  
4 otherwise eligible to vote as a qualified elector and not currently registered may register prior to such  
5 time at the Office of the County Clerk, 102 Grant Avenue, Santa Fe, New Mexico or at the office of  
6 any duly appointed deputy registration officer.

7 All registered, qualified electors in Santa Fe County, New Mexico, shall be entitled to  
8 vote; absentee voting shall be permitted as authorized by the Absent Voter Act, Section 1-6-1, et seq.,  
9 NMSA 1978, as amended. Absentee early voting shall be permitted as authorized by the Absentee-  
10 Early Voting Act, Section 1-6A-1 et seq., NMSA 1978, as amended Applications for absentee ballots  
11 may be obtained from the Office of the County Clerk, 102 Grant Avenue, Santa Fe, New Mexico, but  
12 at 5:00 p.m. on November 2, 1998, the County Clerk is required by statute to destroy unused absentee  
13 ballots, so that completed applications must be returned to the County Clerk prior to such time. The  
14 County Clerk shall accept completed official absentee ballots until 7:00 p.m. on November 3, 1998.

15 Any person wishing to vote by registered, qualified elector absentee early voting may  
16 do so by appearing in person during regular business hours, between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., at the  
17 Absentee Early Voter Precincts listed above, between September 24, 1998 and October 31, 1998.

18 IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, the Board of County Commissioners of Santa Fe County,  
19 New Mexico, being the governing body of the County, has caused this notice to be published as  
20 required by law and dated this 11<sup>th</sup> day of August, 1998.

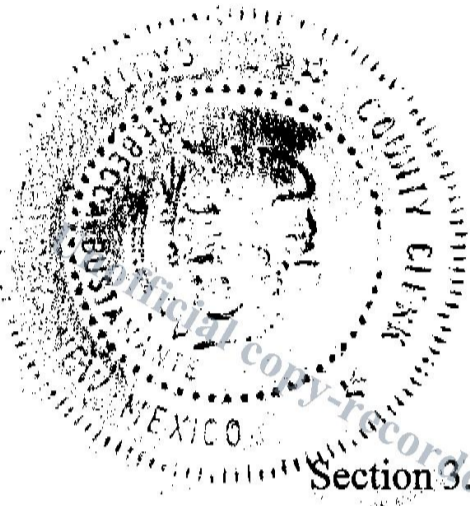

Section 3. The bond question listed in Section 1 of the Bond Election Resolution shall be listed and submitted separately to all qualified registered county electors on a single ballot and shall be so arranged so that a separate tally can be maintained of the votes cast for each question and against each question. Automatic voting machines shall be used except for certain absentee and emergency voting which shall be by paper ballot.

Section 4. The voting machines to be used shall carry ballot labels which shall be the submission clause for the bond questions set forth in Section 1 of the Bond Election Resolution which shall be printed in English and Spanish, of such size as will fit the machines. The complete bond questions to be submitted, in English and Spanish, shall be placed near the place of voting in plain view of the voters so that the complete questions may be examined before they vote. The ballot labels shall be in substantially the following form:

Shall the County of Santa Fe issue \$12,000,000 of General Obligation Bonds to acquire real estate for open space within the County to establish "The Wildlife, Mountain Trails and Historic Places Program"?

1 Section 5. The Chairman or Vice-Chairman of the Board and County Clerk or a Deputy  
2 County Clerk be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to take all action necessary or  
3 appropriate to effectuate the provisions of this Resolution and the Bond Election Resolution, including  
4 the giving of notice pursuant to Section 6-15-1, NMSA 1978, to the Local Government Division of  
5 the Department of Finance and Administration and are directed to attach a copy of the notice and the  
6 reply thereto to the minutes of this meeting.

7  
8 Section 6. The County Clerk or a Deputy County Clerk, is authorized and directed to  
9 take any and all steps necessary for the proper conduct of the election, including giving timely notice  
10 of the election by proclamation by publication and posting thereof and compliance with the Federal  
11 Voting Rights Act.

12  
13 Section 7. All action heretofore taken by the Board, the Chairman or Vice Chairman of  
14 the Board and the County Clerk or a Deputy County Clerk not inconsistent with the provisions of this  
15 Resolution and the Bond Election Resolution be, and the same hereby are, ratified, approved and  
16 confirmed.

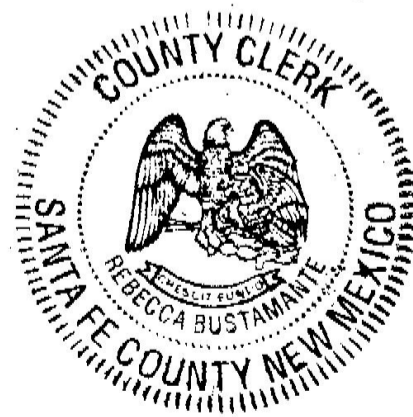
