Behavioral Health Crisis Center— What is It?

OGOAL: To provide a safe and secure place for Santa Fe County adults with behavioral health issues (mental illnesses and/or addictions) and their families and caregivers to receive immediate assistance and find information in times of crisis, and to provide linkage with needed community services.

What Are the Primary Goals?

- To reduce unnecessary admission to hospital emergency departments
- To prevent unnecessary detainment of individuals in criminal facilities
- O To provide immediate crisis management and deescalation support
- To ensure individuals are connected with ongoing clinical and social support, including navigation, to prevent further crisis

Who Will It Serve?

• Adults 18 years old and their families with behavioral health needs who are experiencing a crisis, including mental health and substance abuse

We estimate approximately 2,500 visits per year

What Is the Service Array?

Living Room Model with Peer Supports	Mobile Crisis Response Team	Crisis Triage/Assessment/Brief Intervention/Pharmacy	Navigation Center Offices and Information (co-located)	Safe Sobering Services (co-located)	Residential Detoxification/Treatment Services (co-located)

Core Crisis Services?

- Crisis Services- A living room therapeutic model and services to include screening and brief intervention, assessment, triage, psych, counseling, stabilization, pharmacy, peer services, transportation, short term respite and free standing navigation
- Mobile Crisis-A 24 hour model 7 days per week to respond to behavioral health crisis
- Osobering Services-Up to 24 hours

Co-Located Services

Detox Treatment-Co location of this treatment service at the Behavioral Health Crisis Center (24 hour multi-day treatment).
Navigation-Co location of existing Navigation providers
