

COVID-19 Testing Sites January 2022

The State provides an up-to-date option for finding COVID-19 testing sites at https://cvprovider.nmhealth.org/directory.html. You can search by City (e.g., Santa Fe) or by zip code. Each site states location, hours, whether you need an appointment and if so how to get one, and any other requirements (such as whether you have to be symptomatic).

For employees with children in Santa Fe Public Schools, students with any COVID-19 symptoms can get PCR testing for free at the parking lot in the back of Aspen Middle school at 450 La Madera Street, 8:30 am to 6:00 pm, Monday to Friday. Also, Santa Fe Public Schools parents and students can get tested at the PMG site located at 2540 Camino Edward Ortiz, Suite A, on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays from 10:00 am to 3:00 pm. That site is in the State Auditor's Building near Kohl's.

Free at-home saliva tests are offered at no cost from the State of New Mexico through Vault: https://learn.vaulthealth.com/nm/

The City of Santa Fe offers free shallow swab PCR testing with 24-48 hour results. Most locations and full information are on the DOH link at https://cvprovider.nmhealth.org/directory.html. The basics are listed by provider below:
