Permit Punch Information

Permits will be punched according to the following schedule for **Solid Waste loads**


One punch on Permit or 1 "one trip" card: Up to 5 cubic yards




✓Passenger Vehicles with wastes inside.



✓Up to one ton pick-up trucks loaded **NO HIGHER** than the cab of the vehicle.



✓Passenger Vehicle, or a one-ton pick-up truck without a load inside pulling up to an 8 foot, one axle trailer filled no higher than 4 feet from the trailer floor.



✓Any other combination of vehicles with a load that is equal to the pick-up truck filled to the cab.

Two punches on Permit or 1 "one trip" card: 5-10 cubic yards



✓One ton pick-up with load even with cab pulling a one axle 8' trailer filled no higher than 4 feet from the trailer floor.



✓One ton pick-up trucks loaded **HIGHER** than the cab of the vehicle



✓One ton pick-up trucks loaded to the sides of the bed, pulling a two axle trailer loaded 2' from floor.

Three punches on Card or 1 "one trip" card: 10-15 cubic yards



✓One ton pick-up with load higher than the cab pulling a two-axle trailer filled no higher than 4 feet above the trailer floor.

✓Any other combination of vehicles with a load that is equal to the combination shown above.

✓**Loads larger than example above must deliver wastes to the BuRRT.** (Trucks rated higher than one ton, Double-axle trucks, Rental Trucks, Panel vans, Tipping floor trucks) **BuRRT does not accept county permits.**

Permits will be punched according to the following schedule for **Brush & Tree Waste**



One punch on Permit



Two punches on Permit



Three punches on Permit

Ordinance Requirements

Required Recycling - All recyclable material accepted at Convenience Centers must be separated from refuse and shall be recycled in recycling bins. These materials cannot be placed in with garbage/trash. **Any person placing required recycling items in waste bins will be issued a warning and/or issued a citation.** If found guilty the criminal penalty shall be a fine of not less than \$25.

Large Loads (greater than 15 cubic yards) - Must be delivered to Buckman Road Transfer Station (BuRRT). **Persons unwilling to take loads to the BuRRT can be issued a criminal citation, and if found guilty can be issued a fine not less than \$100.** BuRRT does not accept county permits.

Uncovered Loads - All loads delivered to any Convenience Center must be covered and/or secured. **Any person delivering unsecured loads will be assessed two (2) additional trips (punches) and/or issued a citation.** If found guilty, the criminal penalty shall be a fine of not less than \$50.

Unbagged Loads - All loads of garbage, refuse, rubbish, solid waste, pet wastes delivered to any Convenience Center must be bagged. **Any person delivering unbagged loads will be assessed one (1) additional trip (punch) and/or issued a citation.** If found guilty the criminal penalty shall be a fine of not less than \$25.

Prohibited Materials - Delivery and disposal or attempted delivery of Prohibited Materials can result in confiscation of a permit and/or loss of a permit for 1 year. **If citation is issued, and person is found guilty, violator can be issued a fine not less than \$200 nor more than \$300.**

"Special Wastes"

These wastes require special handling, separation and preparation, before disposal

Separation

Cold Ashes
Construction & Demolition Debris (C & D)
Clean Fill
Clean Woodwaste
Brush & Tree Waste
Motor Oil
Regulated Appliances
Tires
Scrap Metal



Preparation

Cold Ashes - All ashes held until cold before delivery. For centers that take ashes place in designated ash bins.
Woodwaste from construction. No paint and nails.
Household Medical Waste - place used sharps in liquid laundry detergent bottle. Tighten cap throw in trash
Brush & Tree Waste Pieces no longer than 6 feet, 18" in diameter.
Pet Waste - double or triple bag. Tie bags tightly.
Regulated Appliances Refrigerators and air conditioners must have CFC removal sticker affixed before delivery. **Tires - NO RIMS.**
Scrap Metal - Place in scrap area only. None at Tesuque.

Prohibited Materials

- ✓ Livestock waste/manures/ bedding mixed with manure from large animals
- ✓ Asbestos or materials containing asbestos
- ✓ Fuel, gasoline and other flammable materials
- ✓ Any liquid waste
- ✓ Any Auto parts
- ✓ Dead Animals
- ✓ Explosives and Ammunition
- ✓ E-Waste (Electronic Waste)
- ✓ Hazardous Wastes
- ✓ Hot Ashes
- ✓ Industrial Wastes
- ✓ Infectious Waste - Regulated Medical Wastes
- ✓ Large pieces and large loads of concrete, roofing materials, asphalt or rock
- ✓ Petroleum or Chemically Contaminated Soils
- ✓ Pressurized Cylinders
- ✓ Radioactive Waste
- ✓ Sewage, Septage, and Holding Tank Pumpings
- ✓ Sludges
- ✓ Any other Item as Specified by Federal, State or Local Regulation, or as posted on signs
- ✓ Antifreeze
- ✓ Lead Batteries
- ✓ Cooking Oil

Accepted Material	Any cardboard box	Aluminum cans, boxboard (cereal boxes, egg cartons, etc.), brown paper bags, cardboard, food and beverage cartons, junk mail, magazines and catalogs, newspaper, office paper, paperback and hardcover books, phone books, plastic bottles and containers (jars, tubs, clamshells, etc.), rigid plastics (toys, laundry baskets, buckets, etc.), shredded paper (place in clear plastic bags), steel/tin cans	All colors of glass food and beverage bottles and jars.	Gear oil, hydraulic oil, motor oil, power steering fluid, transmission fluid
How to Prepare	Flatten boxes, discard all packing peanuts	Flatten boxes. Keep clean and dry. Rinse lightly. Place loose in containers. No bags. Do not tie with string. Put caps back on plastic and metal bottles and containers (if possible)	Remove lids. Keep glass separate from all other recyclables	Do not mix with other auto fluids
Not Accepted!		Batteries; bubble padded or Tyvek envelopes; electronics; containers which held toxins such as paint, pesticides, and motor oil; food-contaminated containers (i.e. greasy pizza boxes); garden hoses; glass; paper cups; paper towels, napkins, tissues; plastic film (grocery bags, bubble wrap, shrink wrap, food wrappers, etc.); cylinders; scrap metal (place in scrap metal area); Styrofoam; syringes, sharps, or sharp containers; wax coated cardboard; waxy paper (i.e. tea bag wrappers); wrapping paper; foam egg cartons	No ceramics (mugs, plates, etc.) window or plate glass, light bulbs, drinking glasses	Antifreeze, oil that has been mixed with fluids other than those listed (including water), other automotive fluids

Solid Waste Permits

County Residents May Select the Type of Permit that is Best for Each Household

2020

- 1) 3, 6 and 12 Punch Permits may be purchased by households within Santa Fe County, but outside the boundaries of an incorporated city. Convenience Centers do not accept loads larger than 15 cubic yards.
- 2) Permits are non-transferable (cannot be given or loaned to others for use).
- 3) No refunds (lost, stolen, not used).
- 4) Permits do expire: Dec. 31, 2020.
- 5) A permit allows the purchaser use of any of the County Convenience Centers.
- 6) Senior Citizen, Low Income and Veteran Discounts: \$5 for 6 Punch Permits, \$10 for 12 Punch Permits.
- 7) Permits purchased after December 31, 2018 expire at the end of the calendar year in which they were purchased. All permits are non-transferable.
