### **Become an Election Worker for the 2022 General Election in Santa Fe County**

Santa Fe County Clerk Katharine Clark is urging voters of all ages and political parties to sign up to become an election worker for the 2022 General Election. Now more than ever, bipartisan poll workers serve a critical role in election transparency and protecting the right to vote. Serving as an election worker is also a great way to get to know and give back to the community.

The Clerk's Office Election Worker Coordinator, Andrea Tapia, is seeking election workers for Early Voting at the Clerk's Office and at Voting Convenience Centers (VCCs) for Expanded Early Voting and Election Day. She is also seeking temporary workers to serve as elections help desk workers, messengers, and Absentee Board workers.

The Clerk's office has several VCCs throughout the county for Expanded Early Voting and Election Day. Early Voting at the Clerk's Office begins on Tuesday, October 11<sup>th</sup>, and Expanded Early Voting begins on Saturday, October 22<sup>nd</sup>. Anyone interested in working Early Voting must be available for the entire duration.

Election workers are required to provide proof of vaccination against Covid-19 per statute by Santa Fe County. For Early Voting and Election Day workers, this means you must have received your second dose of the Pfizer or Moderna vaccine no later than August 15<sup>th</sup>. For temporary help desk workers and messengers, this means you must have received your second dose of the Pfizer or Moderna vaccine no later than August 1<sup>st</sup>.
