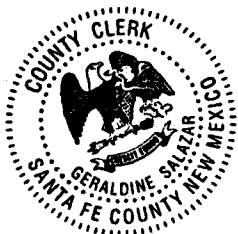

RESOLUTION OF SCHOOL DISTRICT ELECTION

WHEREAS, the Board of Education (the "Board") of the Santa Fe Public School District, County of Santa Fe, State of New Mexico, as the governing board of the Santa Fe Public School District (the "District"), has determined that a special school district election (the "Election") shall be held Tuesday, February 6, 2018, and that a Resolution and Proclamation of the Election shall be issued by the Board, in accordance with Section 1-22-5, NMSA 1978; and;

WHEREAS, the Board has determined upon its own initiative to submit to a vote the question of the imposition of a two-mill levy in the amount and for the purposes hereinafter specified, as permitted by Section 22-25-3, NMSA 1978, at the Election.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE SANTA FE PUBLIC SCHOOL DISTRICT, COUNTY OF SANTA FE, STATE OF NEW MEXICO THAT THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION AND PROCLAMATION BE AND IT HEREBY IS ISSUED:

RESOLUTION AND PROCLAMATION

Section 1. The election for the Santa Fe Public School District, including the locally chartered schools (The Academy for Technology and the Classics, and the state chartered schools, Monte del Sol, New Mexico School for the Arts, The Masters Program, Tierra Encantada, and Turquoise Trail), County of Santa Fe, New Mexico (the "District") shall be held on Tuesday, February 6, 2018.

Section 2. There shall be submitted to all qualified registered electors of the District at the school district election to be held on February 6, 2018, the following question:

"Shall the Santa Fe Public School District continue to impose a property tax of \$2.00 per each \$1,000.00 of net taxable value of property allocated to the Santa Fe Pubic School District for the property tax years 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2022 and 2023 for the purpose of (1) erecting, remodeling, making additions to, providing equipment for or furnishing public school buildings; (2) purchasing or improving public school grounds; (3) maintenance of public school buildings or public school grounds, including the purchasing or repairing of maintenance equipment, participating in the facility information management system as required by the Public School Capital Outlay Act [22-24-1 NMSA 1978] and including payments under contracts with regional education cooperatives for maintenance support services and expenditures for technical training and certification for maintenance and facilities management personnel, but excluding salary expenses of school district employees; (4) purchasing activity vehicles for transporting students to extracurricular school activities; (5) purchasing computer software and hardware for student use in public school classrooms; (6) purchasing and installing education technology improvements, excluding salary expenses of school district employees, but including tools used in the educational process that constitute learning and administrative resources, and which may also

include:

(a) satellite, copper and fiber-optic transmission; computer and network connection devices; digital communication equipment, including voice, video and data equipment; servers; switches; portable media devices, such as discs and drives to contain data for electronic storage and playback; and the purchase or lease of software licenses or other technologies and services, maintenance, equipment and computer infrastructure information, techniques and tools used to implement technology in schools and related facilities; and

(b) improvements, alterations and modifications to, or expansions of, existing buildings or tangible personal property necessary or advisable to house or otherwise accommodate any of the tools listed in (6) above.

FOR Public School Capital Improvements Act Tax

AGAINST Public School Capital Improvements Act Tax

Section 3. The ballot shall present the voter the choice of voting “for the public schools improvement tax or against the public schools improvement tax”.

Section 4. Precincts shall be consolidated for the election pursuant to Section 1-22-6, NMSA 1978, all as hereinafter set forth not to exceed twenty precincts. The precincts, including consolidated precincts, and the location and designation of each polling place are set forth hereafter.

Section 5 The following Voting Convenience Centers will be used for this election. In accordance with 1-3-4(E) NMSA, 1978, each Voting Convenience Center contains a consolidation of precincts. The Voting Convenience Centers VCC# 01 through VCC #15 may be utilized by any eligible voter of the District on Election Day. The Early Voting Locations EVCC01 through EVCC 05 may be utilized by any voter during the early voting period.

Section 6.

For purposes of absentee voting, all precincts are consolidated into one single precinct and the location of the polling place for such absent voter precinct is the office of the County Clerk of Santa Fe County, 102 Grant Avenue, Santa Fe, New Mexico. Absentee voting will be permitted as authorized by Section 1-22-19 NMSA 1978, and the Absent Voter Act of the Election Code, Sections 1-6-1 through 1-6-18, NMSA 1978. Applications for absentee ballots may be obtained from the office of the County Clerk of Santa Fe County, 102 Grant Avenue, Santa Fe, New Mexico. Absentee ballots will be sent to any registered voter in the district requesting a ballot from Tuesday, January 9 through Friday, February 2, 2018, at 5:00 p.m. Absentee ballots of District voters may be marked in person at the office of the County Clerk of Santa Fe, 102 Grant Avenue, Santa Fe, New Mexico, on weekdays from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm beginning on Friday, January 12, 2018, and ending on Friday, February 2, 2018, at 5:00 p.m. At any time prior to 5:00 p.m., on Monday, February 5, 2018, any registered voter in the school district whose absentee ballot application has been accepted and who was mailed an absentee ballot but who has not received the absentee ballot may execute, in the office of the County Clerk of Santa Fe County, a sworn affidavit stating that he/she did not receive or vote his/her absentee ballot. Upon receipt of the sworn affidavit, the County Clerk shall issue the voter a replacement absentee ballot, however, at 5:00 p.m. on Monday, February 5, 2018, the County Clerk is required by statute to destroy unused absentee ballots, so completed applications must be returned to the County Clerk prior to that time. Sealed envelopes containing marked absentee ballots of District voters will be received by the County Clerk of Santa Fe County until 7:00 p.m., February 6, 2018.

Section 7. The polling places will be open between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m., on election day, Tuesday, February 6, 2018. Absentee Early Voting begins on January 12, 2018 at 8:00 a.m. and ends on Friday February 2, 2018 at 5:00 p.m. Early voting begins on January 17, until February 3, 2018. Early voting polling places will be open between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Monday through Saturday, except the County Clerk's Office is closed on Saturdays.

Section 8. The County Clerk of Santa Fe County, New Mexico, is required by law to close the registration books for the election at 5:00 p.m., on Tuesday, January 9, 2018, and a person will be allowed to vote only if he or she is an elector of the District and currently registered to vote in the District at that time. Any qualified elector of the District who is not now registered and who wishes to vote at the election should register during regular office hours at the office of the County Clerk of Santa Fe County, at 102 Grant Avenue, Santa Fe, New Mexico, prior to 5:00 p.m., on Tuesday, January 9, 2018. For federal qualified electors and overseas voters, the County Clerk shall accept a certificate of registration by electronic transmission from a voter qualified to apply for and vote by absentee ballot in the District if the transmission is received before 5:00 p.m. on January 9, 2018.



[Sections 1 through 8 comprise the Resolution and Proclamation]

Section 9. The Resolution and Proclamation shall be published in full in English and Spanish, one time at least fifty (50) days prior to such election, i.e. prior to Monday, December 18, 2017. Additionally, a proclamation with the names of the precinct board members shall be published in English and Spanish once a week for two (2) consecutive weeks, with the last publication being made within seven (7) days but not later than two (2) days before the date of the election. All such publications shall be in the *Santa Fe New Mexican* being a legal newspaper having a general circulation within the District. The Santa Fe County Clerk is directed to publish the Resolution and Proclamation and the proclamation as provided above.

Section 10. The casting of votes by qualified electors at the polling places, including the Absentee polling place, shall be cast on a paper ballot to be tabulated on a voting system authorized under Section 1-9-1, *et. seq.*, NMSA 1978. Qualified District electors will use paper ballots for casting votes.

Section 11. Two sample ballots, in English and Spanish, shall be placed inside the building and two sample ballots in English and Spanish shall be placed outside the building in plain view of the qualified voters so that the complete ballot may be examined before they vote.

Section 12. Pursuant to the Election Code, the Santa Fe County Clerk is to provide paper ballots printed in English and Spanish for use in case of emergency and for absentee voting.

Section 13. The County Clerk of Santa Fe County is requested to conduct the election in accordance with this resolution as provided by Section 1-22-1 *et seq.*, NMSA 1978, the New Mexico Election Code, the Federal Voting Rights Act, and the Public School Capital Improvements Act, as amended, including but not necessarily limited to, making available at the offices of the Clerk of Santa Fe County, and at the appropriate polling places (by being present or on call), Spanish-speaking persons who are fluent in reading, writing and speaking English or persons who are fluent in speaking other minority languages used in the District who are fluent in reading, writing and speaking English.

Section 14. The Superintendent of Schools, the officers of the District, the County Clerk of Santa Fe County be, and they hereby are authorized and directed to take all action necessary or appropriate to effectuate the provisions of this resolution and the Election Resolution and Proclamation.



All action heretofore taken by the Board of Education, the Superintendent and officers of the District not inconsistent with the provisions of this resolution and the aforesaid Election Resolution and Proclamation directed toward the calling and conducting of the election be, and the same hereby is ratified, approved and confirmed.

Section 16. All acts, motions or resolutions, or parts thereof, inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent only of such inconsistency.





RESOLUCIÓN PARA LA ELECCIÓN DEL DISTRITO ESCOLAR

CONSIDERANDO que la Junta de Educación (la “Junta”) del Distrito de las Escuelas Públicas de Santa Fe, Condado de Santa Fe, Estado de Nuevo México, como junta gobernante del Distrito de las Escuelas Públicas de Santa Fe (el “Distrito”), ha determinado que se celebrará una elección especial del distrito escolar (la “Elección”) el martes 6 de febrero de 2018, y que la Junta emitirá una Resolución y Proclamación de la Elección conforme a la Sección 1-22-5 NMSA 1978; y

CONSIDERANDO que la Junta ha determinado por propia iniciativa someter a votación la pregunta de la imposición de un gravamen de dos milésimas de dólar en la cantidad y para los fines especificados más adelante, según lo permite la Sección 22-25-3, NMSA 1978, en la Elección.

AHORA, POR CONSIGUIENTE, LA JUNTA DE EDUCACIÓN DEL DISTRITO DE LAS ESCUELAS PÚBLICAS DE SANTA FE, CONDADO DE SANTA FE, ESTADO DE NUEVO MÉXICO, RESUELVE QUE SE EMITA LA SIGUIENTE RESOLUCIÓN Y PROCLAMACIÓN, Y POR LA PRESENTE SE EMITE:

RESOLUCIÓN Y PROCLAMACIÓN

Sección 1. La elección para el Distrito de las Escuelas Públicas de Santa Fe, que incluye las escuelas localmente autónomas (The Academy for Technology and the Classics, y las escuelas estatales autónomas Monte del Sol, New Mexico School for the Arts, The Masters Program, Tierra Encantada y Turquoise Trail), Condado de Santa Fe, Nuevo México (el “Distrito”), se llevará a cabo el martes 6 de febrero de 2018.

Sección 2. Se deberá someter la siguiente pregunta a todos los electores inscritos calificados del Distrito en la elección del distrito escolar que se llevará a cabo el 6 de febrero de 2018:

“¿Deberá el Distrito de las Escuelas Públicas de Santa Fe seguir imponiendo un impuesto sobre la propiedad de \$2.00 por cada \$1,000.00 del valor neto imponible de propiedad asignado al Distrito de las Escuelas Públicas de Santa Fe durante los años de imposición de impuestos sobre la propiedad 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2022 y 2023 con el fin de (1) erigir, remodelar, hacer ampliaciones, proporcionar equipos o amueblar los edificios de las escuelas públicas; (2) comprar o mejorar los terrenos de las escuelas públicas; (3) mantener los edificios de las escuelas públicas o los terrenos de las escuelas públicas, lo cual incluye la compra o reparación de equipos de mantenimiento, la participación en el sistema de manejo de información de las instalaciones según lo exige la Ley de Desembolsos de Capital de las Escuelas Públicas [22-24-1 NMSA 1978] y los pagos conforme a los contratos con las cooperativas regionales de educación para servicios de apoyo para el mantenimiento y los gastos para la capacitación técnica y la certificación del personal de mantenimiento y de administración de las instalaciones, pero que excluye los gastos del pago de sueldos de los empleados

del distrito escolar; (4) comprar vehículos de actividades para el transporte de estudiantes a actividades escolares extracurriculares; (5) comprar *software* y *hardware* para que usen los estudiantes en las aulas de las escuelas públicas; (6) comprar e instalar mejoras para la tecnología de la educación, lo cual excluye los gastos del pago de sueldos de los empleados del distrito escolar, pero que incluye las herramientas usadas en el proceso educativo que constituyen los recursos para el aprendizaje y los recursos administrativos, y que también podrá incluir:

(a) transmisión por satélite, cable de cobre y fibra óptica; dispositivos de computación y de conexión a redes; equipos de comunicación digital, incluso equipos de voz, de video y de datos; servidores; interruptores; dispositivos portátiles de información, como discos y lectores para contener datos para almacenamiento y reproducción electrónica; y la compra o alquiler de licencias de *software* u otras tecnologías y servicios, mantenimiento, equipos e información de infraestructura informática, técnicas y herramientas usadas para implementar tecnología en las escuelas e instalaciones relacionadas; y

(b) mejoras, alteraciones y modificaciones o ampliaciones de edificios existentes o de bienes personales tangibles necesarios o aconsejables para guardar o de alguna otra manera contener cualquiera de las herramientas indicadas en el punto (6) que aparece más arriba?"

En cualquier momento antes de las 5:00 de la tarde del lunes 5 de febrero de 2018, cualquier votante inscrito en el distrito escolar cuya solicitud de boleta electoral para votar en ausencia haya sido aceptada y a quien se le haya enviado por correo una boleta electoral para votar en ausencia pero que no haya recibido la boleta electoral para votar en ausencia podrá firmar, en la Escribanía del Condado de Santa Fe, una declaración jurada en la que manifieste que no recibió su boleta electoral para votar en ausencia o que no votó con dicha boleta electoral. Al recibir la declaración jurada, la Escribana del Condado le dará al votante una boleta electoral de reemplazo para votar en ausencia. Sin embargo, a las 5:00 de la tarde del lunes 5 de febrero de 2018, la ley exige que la Escribana del Condado destruya las boletas electorales para votar en ausencia que no se hayan usado, por lo cual las solicitudes llenas deben devolverse a la Escribana del Condado antes de esa fecha. La Escribana del Condado de Santa Fe recibirá los sobres sellados que contengan boletas electorales marcadas para votar en ausencia de los votantes del Distrito hasta las 7:00 de la tarde del 6 de febrero de 2018.

Sección 7. Los centros electorales estarán abiertos entre las 7:00 de la mañana y las 7:00 de la tarde del día de la elección, martes 6 de febrero de 2018. La votación anticipada en ausencia comienza el 12 de enero de 2018 a las 8 de la mañana y finaliza el viernes 2 de febrero de 2018 a las 5:00 de la tarde. La votación por anticipado comienza el 17 de enero y finaliza el 3

de febrero de 2018. Los centros electorales para votación por anticipado estarán abiertos entre las 8:00 de la mañana y las 5:00 de la tarde de lunes a sábado, excepto la Escribanía del Condado que permanece cerrada los sábados.

Sección 8. La ley exige que la Escribana del Condado de Santa Fe, Nuevo México, cierre los libros de registro para las elecciones a las 5:00 de la tarde del martes 9 de enero de 2018, y se permitirá votar solamente a quienes sean electores del Distrito y que estén inscritos actualmente para votar en el Distrito en ese momento. Cualquier elector calificado del Distrito que no esté actualmente inscrito y que desee votar en las elecciones deberá inscribirse durante las horas hábiles regulares en la Escribanía del Condado de Santa Fe, 102 Grant Avenue, Santa Fe, Nuevo México, antes de las 5:00 de la tarde del martes 9 de enero de 2018. Para los electores calificados a nivel federal y los votantes que se encuentren en el extranjero, la Escribana del Condado aceptará un certificado de inscripción por transmisión electrónica de todo votante que esté calificado para solicitar una boleta electoral para votar en ausencia y para votar en ausencia en el Distrito si la transmisión se recibe antes de las 5:00 de la tarde del 9 de enero de 2018.
