Re: Secured Drop Box Container Notice for the 2025 Regular Local Election

Pursuant to NMSA §1-6-9 and NMAC 1.10.19, the Santa Fe County Clerk must make a certain number of 24-hour, secured containers available to voters for the return of absentee ballots during an election. The locations and information related to secured containers for the **2025 Regular Local Election** are below.

Absentee ballots may be returned by the voter or the voter's caregivers by mail or in-person using secured containers, at any Early Voting site, at any Election Day voting site or at the Santa Fe County Clerk's Office. Per state law, "immediate family" means the spouse, children, parents, or siblings of a voter. There will be a space on the ballot envelope where a person returning an envelope should indicate their relationship to the voter.

7. Pojoaque Satellite Office – 5 W. Gutierrez Ste. 9, Pojoaque Pueblo Plaza, 17839 US-84, Santa Fe, NM
8. Max Coll Corridor Center – 16 Avenida Torreon (Eldorado), Santa Fe, NM
9. SFC Edgewood Satellite – 114 Quail Trail, Edgewood, NM
