REBECCA BUSTAMANTE (County Clerk): I just want to start the official canvassing. You have before you the unofficial results. [Exhibit 1] They will be changing because we do have probably about 35 provisional ballots that we will be checking to see if in fact they will count. We don't anticipate much of a change either way but the numbers will change. Other than that, I now would like to get approval to start the canvassing and stand in recess until Tuesday. We should finish it before the Commission meeting on Tuesday. You can sign off on it and we'll answer any of your specific questions. In regard to precinct results, they're being posted on the website so you can go into the website this afternoon and get individual precincts.

CHAIRMAN CAMPOS: When do you think you're going to have the final?

MS. BUSTAMANTE: Tuesday before the meeting.

CHAIRMAN CAMPOS: At the next BCC meeting.

MS. BUSTAMANTE: Right. We have to turn in the final by Friday to the

Secretary of State's office but we anticipate we should get it down by Tuesday.

CHAIRMAN CAMPOS: Okay, as I understand it there's a statute that allows the BCC to authorize you to commence.

MS. BUSTAMANTE: That's the only way we can start. Yes. That's the way we've been doing it. This is the way we've done it for seven and a half years.

COMMISSIONER DURAN: Mr. Chair, I'd like to make a motion that we authorize the County Clerk to begin the canvassing process.

COMMISSIONER ANAYA: Second. CHAIRMAN CAMPOS: Discussion?

MS. BUSTAMANTE: And stand in recess until Tuesday.

The motion to authorize the commencement of canvassing passed by unanimous [4-0] voice vote. [Commissioner Montoya was not present for this action.]

CHAIRMAN CAMPOS: Okay, then we'll stand in recess until Tuesday morning at the regular BCC.

MS. BUSTAMANTE: Well, that's the first meeting. We usually start that in the afternoon. It's the first meeting of the month and that's usually in the afternoon.

CHAIRMAN CAMPOS: So you want us to recess -

MS. BUSTAMANTE: Until maybe a half hour before the 3:00 meeting.

COMMISSIONER DURAN: Let's just start at 3:00.

MS. BUSTAMANTE: And we'll just finish this up.

CHAIRMAN CAMPOS: Okay. Thank you very much.

MS. BUSTAMANTE: Thank you.

STEVE ROSS (County Attorney): Mr. Chair, one of the items we have on the agenda here today was closed executive session to discuss acquisition and disposal of water rights.

CHAIRMAN CAMPOS: Ms. Bustamante, what date did we meet to initiate

MS. BUSTAMANTE: On June 2nd. And we're in recess.

CHAIRMAN CAMPOS: Okay, we need to come out of recess from a meeting scheduled on June 2nd where we initiated and gave the Clerk authorization to do the canvassing. Do we need a motion to do that? I guess we do. Is there a motion?

COMMISSIONER MONTOYA: So moved. CHAIRMAN CAMPOS: Is there a second? COMMISSIONER SULLIVAN: Second.

The motion to reconvene the canvassing meeting passed by unanimous [4-0] voice vote.

MS. BUSTAMANTE: Mr. Chair, members of the Commission, I just would like to say that we finished the canvassing and 18,724 individuals voted, 69,224 were eligible to vote, 27 percent of the eligible voters came out to vote, so that's pretty good for Santa Fe County. As you know, on election night the results are unofficial until we canvas. We had quite

a few provisional ballots. The provisional ballots that we counted, 38 of them, those split evenly – well, actually there were more than that but the race that everybody's interested is in the Treasurer's race and the provisional ballots that were counted, they were either provisional ballots or what we call in-lieu-of ballots. In lieu ballots are ballots where an individual shows up at the precinct and their name is either marked "Absentee ballot" saying that they received a ballot. They swear under oath they never received a ballot, or if they did, they just didn't vote it, and they're allowed to vote a paper ballot.

So with the provision ballots and the in-lieu-of ballots, those in that particular race were evenly divided. Each candidate got 19 of the votes. So with 19-19, that left it at 86. In the canvassing, we discovered that precinct 73, for some reason the cartridge that we take out of the machine did not read on election night, but the votes were tallied and the print out for the precinct showed that there were two machines so we were able to catch that. We checked our cartridge and we were able to get it to read after we had changed the batteries, even though we had changed batteries for all the cartridges. So we're not exactly sure what happened.

But in that particular race, there were 43 extra votes. Most of those were Republican votes but there were a few Democratic votes. And two of those votes went to Victor Montoya. So the spread now between Victor Montoya and Fiorina is like two more votes. So it's an 88 difference rather than an 86.

Some of you read in the paper this morning that it was really 82-84. That was because the press was here yesterday and they wanted a print-out of what we had entered to that time. As I indicated to the press, it's unofficial until we bring it before this board. And we had not had time to really check numbers and make sure that all the numbers were in and as we checked them yesterday, late last night, we found there was a two-vote difference that hadn't been entered on a provisional. They were provisional votes that had just been missed.

So this is your official results. I stand for questions.

CHAIRMAN CAMPOS: Questions, Commissioners? Okay. No questions. Thank you very much.

MS. BUSTAMANTE: Thank you.

COMMISSIONER ANAYA: Mr. Chair.

CHAIRMAN CAMPOS: Commissioner Anaya.

COMMISSIONER ANAYA: I move that we accept these.

CHAIRMAN CAMPOS: The canvass results for Santa Fe County for the primary held on June 1, 2004.

COMMISSIONER ANAYA: Yes.

CHAIRMAN CAMPOS: Okay, there's a second?

COMMISSIONER MONTOYA: Second. CHAIRMAN CAMPOS: Discussion?


