#### 1. When is the election?

The Regular Local Election will be held on Tuesday, November 4, 2025.

2. Will there be any training provided to candidates?

To withdrawal, please fill out the <u>Affidavit of Withdrawal of Candidacy</u>. The last day to withdraw is no later than **Tuesday**, **September 2**, **2025**.

7. When will I be notified if I have qualified to be a candidate on the ballot? No Later than Friday, August 29, 2025.

The proper filing officer shall determine whether a candidate filing a declaration of candidacy is registered to vote within the area to be elected to represent and, if required for the office being sought, whether the candidate's nominating petition for that office has been filed with a number of signatures that is equal to or greater than the number required for that office.

If the candidate is so qualified and no withdrawal of candidacy has been filed as provided in the Local Election Act, the proper filing officer shall place the candidate's name on the ballot for the position specified in the declaration of candidacy and notify each candidate in writing no later than 5:00 p.m. on the sixty-seventh (67) day before the local election.

- **8.** Which positions have campaign finance reporting requirements? The position of College Board is a covered office. The following deadlines are application:
  - 1st Report due: Tuesday, October 14, 2025
  - 2nd Report due: Thursday, December 4, 2025
