A Capital Project...

- Is a project to construct either a new level of service (LOS) for adequate public facilities; or
- enhance and make significant, long-term improvements to existing LOS.
 - Facilities, safe roads, bike paths and trails, water or wastewater projects.
- Have a life expectancy of at least 10 years;





A Capital Project...

- Cost is greater than \$10,000.
- Must have good cost estimates, scope of work, purpose and justification.
- Provide potential funding sources.
- Have a realistic timeline.

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING PROJECTS FOR INCLUSION IN SANTA FE COUNTY'S INFRASTRUCTURE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN FOR FISCAL YEARS 2025-2029; AUTHORIZING SUBMITTAL OF PLAN TO THE NEW MEXICO DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION; AND REPLACING RESOLUTION 2023-088

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners (the "Board") of Santa Fe County recognizes that the financing of public capital projects is an important aspect of local government; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to access multiple financing mechanisms in order to maximize capital resources; and

WHEREAS, capital improvements planning is an effective tool to help prioritize projects that should be developed and identify concrete actions and strategies to achieve project development; and

WHEREAS, short and long range capital planning contributes to local and regional efforts to identify and select projects; and

WHEREAS, a list of projects for inclusion in the County's Infrastructure and Capital Improvement Plan (ICIP) for Fiscal Years (FY) 2025-2029 was developed in a series of meetings among citizens, staff, and elected officials from various levels of government; and

WHEREAS, the Board reviewed the list of potential projects at its meetings on July 25, 2023, August 08, 2023, November 28, 2023, and January 9, 2024.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED as follows:

1. The Board hereby adopts as Santa Fe County's FY 2025-2029 ICIP the list of projects that staff presented to the Board at its January 9, 2024, meeting. The list of projects is attached as Exhibit A.

 Staff shall submit the ICIP to the State of New Mexico, Department of Finance and Administration, and prioritize the projects in accordance with the Board's comments.

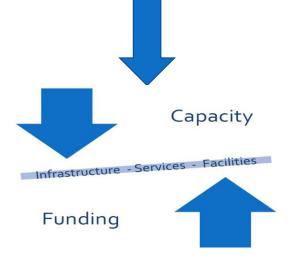

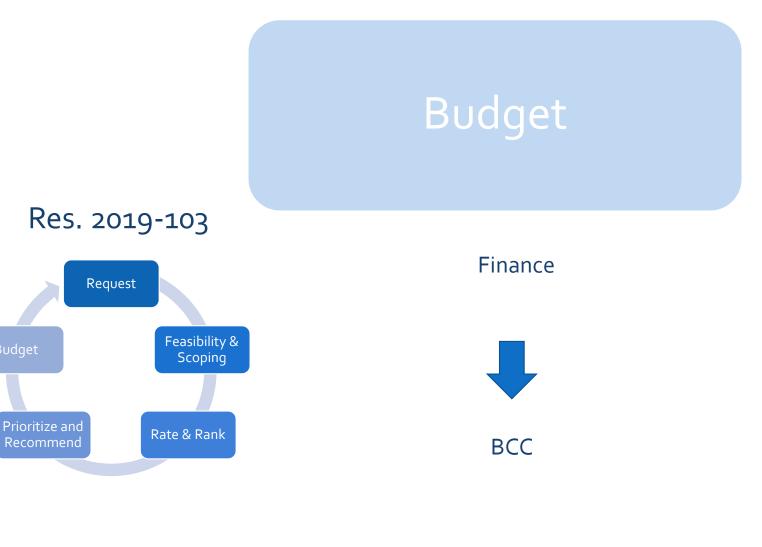






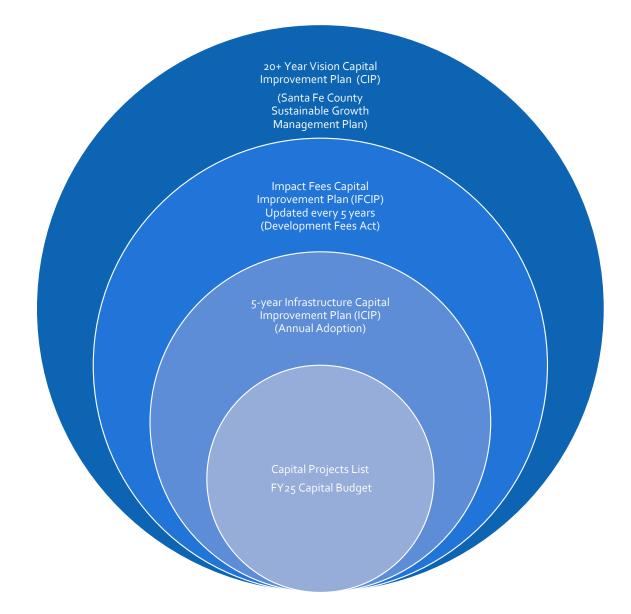
