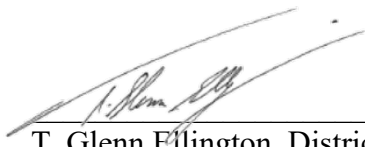
ORDER GRANTING VERIFIED, EXPEDITED PETITION

THIS MATTER came before the Court upon the Verified, Expedited Petition of the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Santa Fe, (County) and Katharine E. Clark, Santa Fe County Clerk, to Replace the Polling Place/Voter Convenience center (VCC) within County Consolidated Precinct No. 22 for All Statewide Elections Held in 2026 and to Add a VCC for Consolidated Precinct No. 22 for All Statewide Elections Held in 2027. The Court, being sufficiently advised in the premises, finds that the Petition is well-taken and should be GRANTED.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED THAT

- a. “Pojoaque Valley High School, 1575 State Road 502 West” is replaced with “El Rancho Senior Center, 394 Co Rd 84” as a VCC within Consolidated Precinct No. 3 for all statewide elections held in 2026 and 2027;
- b. “Christian Life Church, 121 Siringo Road” is replaced with “La Farge Library, 1730 Llano St.” as the VCC for Consolidated Precinct No. 16 for all statewide elections held in 2026 and 2027;
- c. “Madrid Volunteer Fire Station, 5 Firehouse Ln” is added as a VCC for Consolidated Precinct No. 21, with the designation of “Turquoise Trail Charter Elementary School, 13 A San Marcos Loop,” “Madrid Volunteer Fire Station, 5 Firehouse Ln,” and/or “Los Cerrillos Senior Center, 12 Main Street, Los Cerrillos, NM” as VCCs for all statewide elections held in 2026 and 2027, provided that the Clerk publishes a notice, more than 120 days before any statewide election, indicating which polling place(s) will be used in such statewide election;

IT IS SO ORDERED.
