Pursuant to NMSA §1-6-5.6 and §1-6-5.7, the Santa Fe County Clerk's Office hereby provides the early voting schedule for the 2026 General Election.

Early Voting at the County Clerk's Office

- **Begins:** Tuesday, October 6, 2026
- **Ends:** Saturday, October 31, 2026
- **Hours:** Monday–Friday, 8:00 AM – 5:00 PM
- **Saturday Voting:** Saturday, October 31, 2026, from 10:00 AM – 6:00 PM

Please note: The Clerk's Office will be closed on Monday, October 12, 2026, in observance of Indigenous Peoples' Day.

Same Day Registration (SDR)

Same Day Registration will be available at all early voting and Election Day polling sites. To register or update your voter registration and vote on the same day, you must provide **physical identification** issued by the federal government, a state government, a federally recognized Indian nation, tribe or pueblo, or an educational institution. The ID must:

1. **Contain your name**, which must reasonably match the name provided on the registration form
2. **Contain your photograph**, which must reasonably resemble you
3. **Not be required to have a valid expiration date**, but if one is present, it does not need to be current
4. **Include one of the following:**
 - An address that matches the address on your registration form, or
 - Be accompanied by an original or copy of a utility bill, bank statement, government check, paycheck, or a document issued by an educational institution or government (including tribal governments), dated within 90 days of registering, that includes your name and address matching your registration

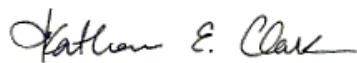
Note: Absentee ballots may be returned by voters, voters' immediate family members, or voters' caregivers inside any early voting site drop boxes or the official drop box outside the Santa Fe County Clerk's office.

Contingency Plan

As part of Santa Fe County's contingency planning for the 2026 General Election, the Santa Fe County Clerk's Office will utilize its Mobile Voting Unit as a replacement voting location if an early voting site or Election Day polling location becomes unavailable due to an emergency or other unforeseen circumstances. This contingency measure is intended to ensure uninterrupted access to voting services for Santa Fe County voters.
