Santa Fe County Clerk Katharine E. Clark Announces Record-Breaking Turnout and Efficient Voting as Polls Remain Open for Regular Local Election

Santa Fe – As the Regular Local Election heads into its final hours, Santa Fe County Clerk Katharine E. Clark is reporting unprecedented absentee ballot returns and robust early voting figures that are outpacing the rest of the state. Polling locations are open until 7:00 PM, with voters still able to register and vote at [any](#) polling place today.

"Our office has launched #TeamTurnout, a candidate and ballot initiative campaign education program, which along with our ongoing public information and social media campaigns, has contributed to an incredible turnout," says Clerk Clark. "We are seeing record numbers, with Santa Fe County leading in voter participation across New Mexico. We are fully committed to maintaining this momentum through to the close of polls."

Polling Location Information and Wait Times

Voters can vote at any of the 33 [polling locations](#) and view real-time wait times for all polling sites at [SantaFe.vote](#). Polls will remain open until 7:00 PM, and anyone in line by that time will be allowed to vote.

Absentee Ballots

Absentee ballots must be in the hands of the Clerk's Office by 7:00 PM to be counted. Voters can track the status of their absentee ballot at [SantaFe.vote](#). For those who have yet to submit, do not mail the ballot, please use an official dropbox or polling location. All locations can also be found on our website.

Same-Day Registration

Santa Fe County offers same-day registration at all polling sites. To register today, simply provide a photo ID with the correct address or a photo ID with any document that verifies your name and address.
