To check your voter registration status, register to vote, or update your voter information, please visit [NMVote.org](https://nmvote.org). The online voter registration information portal is user-friendly and available 24/7, providing residents with a convenient and accessible source of information.

Santa Fe County Clerk Katharine E. Clark highlighted the simplicity of the online registration process, saying, "Registering to vote online at [NMVote.org](https://nmvote.org) is incredibly easy and convenient. It takes just a few minutes to complete, and it ensures that your registration information is accurate and up to date ahead of the 2023 Regular Local Election."

In addition to the online registration option, voter registration forms can be obtained at the Santa Fe County Clerk's Office located at 100 Catron St. during regular business hours.

Remember, the same day voting begins, voter registration at [NMVote.org](https://nmvote.org) and via paper will close on October 10th. However, constituents can still register and vote using the same-day registration process at any Early Voting or Election Day polling site during voting hours.
