Reminder from County Clerk Katharine E. Clark: Expanded Early Voting Begins May 18th

Santa Fe – After two weeks of voting at the Clerk's Office, voting has expanded to several additional locations throughout Santa Fe County. These are Voting Convenience Centers, meaning that as long as a voter lives in Santa Fe County, they are eligible to vote at any of these sites.

“New Mexico has semi-closed primaries,” explained Clark, “which means only voters who are registered with the Republican, Libertarian, or Democratic parties are eligible to vote in this election. However, we have Same Day Registration available at Early Voting and Election Day sites, which allows minor party and independent voters to switch their registrations to a major party to be eligible to vote.”

Expanded Early Voting sites are open Tuesday - Friday 11am - 7pm, and Saturdays 10am to 6pm. Find more information about these locations here: SantaFe.vote/pollinglocations
