Polls Closed — Results Coming Soon

Santa Fe County, NM — The Santa Fe County Clerk's Office reports that all polls have officially closed.

Santa Fe County saw strong voter participation in this year's Regular Local Election, surpassing turnout from the previous RLE, which recorded 30.98%. Voters turned out enthusiastically on Election Day, with in-person Election Day voting exceeding the combined total of early and absentee ballots.

- **Total turnout:** 36026 (31.5%)
- **Early & absentee votes:** 17,852 (15.6 %)
- **Election Day votes:** 18,454 (16.1%)

Final turnout may increase slightly as remaining ballots — including those from voters who were in line at 7 p.m. and any absentee ballots pending verification — are processed.

Absentee and early voting results will be released momentarily. Election Day results will begin posting throughout the night as data is received from polling sites across Santa Fe County.

The Santa Fe County Clerk's Office will also livestream the Ranked Choice Voting (RCV) tabulation rounds on Election Night — providing the public, candidates, and media with a transparent, real-time view of how each round unfolds until a candidate achieves a true majority.

“There’s no better way to build trust in the process than by letting voters see it for themselves,” said Clerk Katharine E. Clark. “This livestream shows democracy in motion — every round, every step of the count.”

The Clerk's Office will begin running RCV rounds once a statistically significant number of ballots have been received and verified — meaning that all polling sites and nearly all absentee ballots have been processed and uploaded. The RCV tabulation is not expected to begin before 9:00 p.m. on Election Night.
