

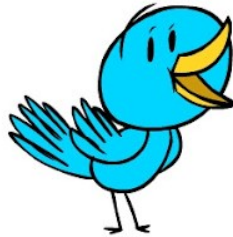
# Test your Smoke Alarms!



## BEEP-BEEP-BEEP...

The “BEEP-BEEP-BEEP” sound can mean there is a fire in your home.

Be prepared to leave quickly!



## CHIRP!

The “chirp” sound means the battery may be low, or the smoke alarm is getting old.

Be sure to replace the battery!



## PUSH TO TEST!

1. Push in and hold the test button for a few seconds.
2. If you hear BEEP BEEP BEEP, that means the smoke alarm is working.
3. If you don't hear that sound, replace the battery or get a new smoke alarm.
