A Resolution to Amend Santa Fe County Resolution 2001-114 Development Permit and Regular Permit Fees for Santa Fe County Fire Department

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Santa Fe County has determined that, wherever possible, an applicant for any type of development or any other permitted activity in Santa Fe County, including the Extra Territorial Zone, requiring review, inspection and/or approval for fire and life safety code compliance should be required to pay for certain fees which are directly related to the application, review or permit;

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners previously adopted Santa Fe County Resolution 2001-114; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners desires to amend Santa Fe County Resolution 2001-114.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Santa Fe County that Resolution 2001-114 is hereby amended and replaced in totality as follows:

Any applicant for development, review, inspection and permit required applications pursuant to the Santa Fe County Fire Code, Ordinance 1998-11, shall pay the following amended fees.




