



# Recyclable Materials List



Per County Ordinance 2014-10, the following materials are required to be recycled at Convenience Centers:

Keep it Simple! Use 2 storage bins (or other container) at your home and flatten cardboard boxes.

## “Mixed” Bin

- White and colored office paper
- Newspapers (& all inserts), magazines, catalogs, envelopes, junk mail
- Aluminum: empty cans, foil and pie pans
- Plastic: empty # 1 & 2 bottles, jugs, and jars (e.g. coffee containers) – look on bottom of container for recycling number. Remove caps/lids.
- Tin Cans: empty cans

Place in “Mixed Recyclables” bin at Convenience Center.

## “Glass Only” Bin

- Glass bottles and jars of any color. Remove lids.

Place in “Glass Only” bin at Convenience Center.



## Corrugated Cardboard (wavy layer in middle):

- Flatten. Cardboard does not need to be bundled or tied together. Discard packing peanuts. Brown paper bags can be placed with cardboard.

Place in “Cardboard” bin at Convenience Center.

---

**NO!** The following items are currently not recyclable and should not be placed in Convenience Center recycling bins.

- Plastic: bags, #3-#7 plastic (tubs, to-go containers, yogurt containers), motor oil containers
- Cereal, soda and pizza boxes, paper towels
- Light bulbs, window or auto glass, Pyrex, drinking glasses, ceramics
- Containers used for paint or flammable or hazardous materials
