

Pojoaque Valley Planning Committee Meeting Summary
Thursday, March 23rd, 2006 6:30pm – 8:30pm

David Dogruel opened the meeting at 6:40pm.

Announcements:

- ⇒ No new information has been heard about school funding and how the old school building will be used. David D. is still awaiting any updates.
- ⇒ The high-speed Internet petition has been passed around, and the subcommittee has received 400 signatures. Chuck Berger said he was going to compile the information and give it to Ben Ray Lujan at the Public Regulations Commission for submittal to Qwest. This petition will require Qwest to look into infrastructure options for high-speed Internet in the Valley.
- ⇒ Renee V. reminded the committee that the Dept of Transportation will be holding another public forum to get feedback about the road construction and redesign of the 1 mile stretch of 84/285 between the 503 light and CR 109. The meeting will be held on Wed., March 29th from 5:30 to 7:30pm at the old high school gym.

Land Use Table:

The committee worked on the remainder of the land use table and discussed what uses should be relevant to the Valley. The group looked at Retail Sales and Service, Industrial, and Agriculture and Agricultural Business uses. The committee discussed each of the categories and made suggestions about which uses should fall under a permitted, conditional, special, and not permitted.

The meeting ended at 9:00pm.

The committee will finish up the Residential Uses categories at the next meeting. The next meeting will be held on **Thursday, April 6th** at the Sammy Quintana Board Room from 6:30pm to 8:30pm.
